Drill 11 3/4" surface hole to 300' and set 8 5/8" J-55 14 casing with 135 sacks cement. Drill 7 7/8" hole to total depth 3350' and set 4 1/2" J-55 9.50 casing with 200 sacks cement. Perforate Delaware sand. Wash perforations with 200 gallons mud acid and sandfree with 1000 gallons lease crude with 1 pound sand per gallon.
