MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

Yates Petroleum Corporation Lily "ALY' Federal #7 660' FSL and 1980' FEL Section 3-T24S-R31E Eddy County, New Mexico

This plan is submitted with Form 3160-3, Application for Permit to Drill, covering the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of the surface disturbance involved and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operations, so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effect associated with the operations.

1. EXISTING ROADS:

Exhibit A is a portion of BLM map showing the well and roads in the vicinity of the proposed location. The proposed well site is located approximately 24 miles northeast of Loving, New Mexico and the access route to the location is indicated in red and green on Exhibit A.

DIRECTIONS:

Go east out of Carlsbad on Highway 285 to Highway 31. Go east on Highway 31 to Highway 128 (Jal Highway). Go approximately 16 miles just before Red Road. Turn right down caliche road and go approximately 1.5 miles. New access will start here.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD

- A. The proposed new access will be approximately 2100' in length from the point of origin to the southeast edge of the drilling pad. The road will go southwest 800' and west 1300'.
- B. The new road will be 14 feet in width (driving surface) and will be adequately drained to control runoff and soil erosion.
- C. The new road will be bladed with drainage on two sides. One traffic turnout will be built.
- D. The route of the road is visible.

3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELL

- A. There is drilling activity within a one-mile radius of the well site.
- B. Exhibit D shows existing wells within a one-mile radius of the proposed well site.

4. LOCATION OF EXISTING AND/OR PROPOSED FACILITIES

- A. There are no production facilities on this lease at the present time.
- B. In the event that the well is productive, the necessary production facilities will be installed on the drilling pad. If the well is productive oil, a gas or diesel self-contained unit will be used to provide the necessary power. No power will be required if the well is productive of gas.

5. LOCATION AND TYPE OF WATER SUPPLY:

A. It is planned to drill the proposed well with a fresh water system. The water will be obtained from commercial sources and will be hauled to the location by truck over the existing and proposed roads shown in Exhibit A.
