cactus, tree cholla, and eagle claw cactus.

Lithic Resources: Outside the surveyed area

Water Sources: (Potential) Threemile Draw, north, 1900' (Permanent) Black River, southeast, 3 1/4 miles

4. Examination Procedure:

Straight and zig-zag line transects, spaced not greater than 15 meters apart.

Area Delineation: Originally only the well pad was staked, but after DWAS brought up the fact

that the road was not staked, the client staked the access road at a later date.

Visibility: 80-90%

Lighting Conditions: great

Weather: sunny, warm, and calm (on both dates)

Work Hours on the Ground: 2 hours (9-26-1997; 1 archaeologist), and ½ hour (10-1-1997; 2

archaeologists)

5. Findings:

A BLM and ARMS prefield study was completed by Danny Boone on 9-25-1997. According to these records, there are no previously recorded sites with a 1/4 mile radius of the proposed project's area.

6. Recommendations:

Archaeological clearance for the Mallon 16 State Well number 8 and access road is recommended.
