Reference is made to your application dated December 1, 1997 on behalf of the operator Chi Energy, Inc. for an unorthodox Morrow gas well location for its proposed USA "9" Federal Com Well No. 2 to be drilled 600 feet from the North line and 510 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 9, Township 20 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Burton Flat-Morrow Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The E/2 of said Section 9 being a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool is to be dedicated to said well.
