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I. Purpose

The purpose of this work plan is to propose a plan for the cleanup of the area impacted by the spillage of approximately 23 barrels of produced crude oil from a gathering line associated with production in the area. The subject area is located in Section 16, Township 17S Range 32E in Lea County, New Mexico. This plan will allow closure in a manner that will protect the population, environment and groundwater of the area surrounding the subject location. The site is a relatively level site located on Bureau of Land Management (BLM) land.

II. Background

The subject site is adjacent to the west side of County Road 126A.

III. Contaminant and Size of Area

The suspected contaminant is crude oil, which leaked from a gathering line associated with production in the area. The approximate size of the impacted area is approximately 800 sq. ft. No evidence of other contaminants was observed.

IV. Vertical and Horizontal Extent of Contamination

Vertical and horizontal extent of the contamination will be determined at the time of excavation.

V. Groundwater

The nearest groundwater of record with the New Mexico State Engineer's Office is in Section 11 and 12 of 17S, 32E. The depth to water in Section11 is 105.86 feet. The depth to water in Section 12 is 120.13 feet.

VI. Action Plan

Closure

Based on visual observations, the cleanup level reached by the application of the "Guidelines for Remediation of Leaks, Spills and Releases" New Mexico Oil Conservation Division – August 13, 1993 (Guidelines) to this site is 5000 ppm TPH. Application of the NMOCD's ranking criteria for contaminated soils at this site is presented below.

Depth to Ground Water:	0 points
Distance to Well Head or Water Source:	0 points
Distance to Surface Water/Waterways:	0 points
Total Score:	0 points

The site will be excavated both horizontally and vertically for the removal all highly contaminated and/or saturated soils as defined in the Guidelines. The excavated soils will be blended on-site with adjacent clean soils to a level no greater than 5000 ppm TPH.

The bottom and sides of the excavation will be sampled at the final excavation depths. Field-testing for Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TPH) will be performed on soil samples (EPA Method 418.1) using a GAC Mega Total Petroleum Hydrocarbon analyzer. The final samples collected will be preserved on ice and delivered along with Chain of Custody to Cardinal Laboratories, of Hobbs, New Mexico, for testing. Laboratory samples will be analyzed for Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons (EPA Method 600/4-79-020 418.1), BTEX (EPA Method SW-846-8260) and Chlorides (EPA methods 4500-CI⁻B).

Following the final sampling, the excavation will be backfilled with the blended soils and returned to natural grade. The site will be reseeded with BLM #4.

After completion of the project, the appropriate reports will be filed with the NMOCD in the closure report.
