BURNED FIBERGLASS TANK DOWN TO WATER LEVEL. MINIMAL SPILL WITHIN CONTAINMENT. NO DAMAGE TO CONTAINMENT LINER. PRODUCTION SHUT DOWN WITHIN AN HOUR. ESTIMATED RELEASE OF 69BBLS. WATER RECOVERED USING VACUUM TRUCK.
BURNT TANK WAS REMOVED, LINER INSPECTED. NO DAMAGE TO LINER. NEW TANK WAS INSTALLED. WELL PUT BACK ON PRODUCTION. BEFORE AND AFTER PHOTOS ATTACHED.
