In an effort to begin reclamation of 23/26 battery contractor removing clean caliche from 23/26 battery and repairing roads was left unsupervised. Contractor dumped several loads of potentially contaminated soil on roads as a result. Soil samples have been collected and sent to Hall Environmental of Albuquerque NM for further review.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
The battery itself has soil staining that is considered historic. The lease road in question, soil samples have been collected. Waiting on analysis to determine the degree of action needed.
