A one inch union on the circulating line vibrated loose causing 15 bbls of produced water to leak onto the ground. A vacuum truck recovered 5 bbls of water and the union was replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The affected area is approximately 15' x 22' and 12' x 20' on location. Remediation will be completed in accordance with a remediation plan approved by NMOCD and the BLM.
