
Gasket failure on the heater treater caused 6 bbls of oil and 15 bbls of produced water to leak onto the ground, inside the berm. A vacuum truck recovered 5 bbls of fluids and the gasket was replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The affected area is approximately 15' x 30' on location inside the berm. Remediation will be completed in accordance with a remediation plan approved by NMOCD.
