The valve was immediately shut and removed to prevent future occurrences. Notifications were made internally to operation's leadership and environmental. Frontier estimated the release to exceed 5bbl and made prompt notifications to NMOCD and BLM. On 6/17/2015 approximately 3bbl of free liquid was recovered from the surface with a hydrovac truck and disposed at an OCD approved facility.
