Frac tanks at the Trionyx Treatment Facility overfilled due to human error causing a spill of 56 barrels of produced water to overflow inside the lined containment. Pumps were shut down at the batteries to stop the overflow.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

56 barrels of produced water overflowed inside the lined containment at the Trionyx Treatment Facility. Liner was checked for holes and no holes were found; therefore the spill did not touch the pad or leave the lease. A vacuum truck was used to recover the entire spill of 56 barrels of produced water.
