DCP Midstream's V-3-7-2 8-inch steel sweet gas pipeline was reported to have a blowing leak. DCP's construction crew was dispatched to depressurize and repair the line.

An estimated six bbls of condensate leaked from the line and impacted a 30' x 50' area on private land. DCP will vacuum up free liquids and remediate the area.
