At the NMOCD's request, Great Western Drilling Company has reviewed historical and current aerial imagery related to vegetation at the location. This review suggests that a release may have occurred in the past as a change in vegetation appears in imagery from September 1991. The initial review of the suspected release did not suggest any impact to a watercourse. Great Western plans to perform an assessment of current conditions at the site and to address any visual staining at the location.
