The valve on the circulating line was left open causing 60 bbls of oil to spill inside the containment. A vacuum truck recovered 59 bbls and the valve was restored to the correct position.

The affected area is approximately 40' x 120' on location inside containment. Remediation will be completed in accordance with a remediation plan approved by NMOCD and the BLM.
