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Dear Ms. Vandenberg:

NMOCD approves of the proposed delineation plan for 1RP-4820 with these modifications.

1. Due to the presence of a surface waterbody approximately 750 ft. Southwest, permissible TPH levels are 1000 mg/kg, not 5000 mg/kg.
2. For complete vertical delineation, permissible levels of chlorides,  $\leq 600$  mg/kg, must be obtained and maintained for 10 ft. further in depth.
3. For each sample location, at least two depths must be submitted for laboratory analyses: depth obtained and depth maintained permissible levels of BTEX, TPH extended, and chlorides. All laboratory analyses must have accompanying field data.
4. Provide all pertinent field data for samples at depths without laboratory analyses.

Please confirm or inform if clarification is necessary.

Like approval from NMLS0 is required. NMSLO may have additional stipulations.
