Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* A four (4) inch low pressure steel natural gas pipeline developed a leak, resulting in a release of natural gas, crude oil, and produced water. During initial response activities the pipeline was clamped to mitigate the release. The affected steel pipeline was cut and capped and permanently taken out of service. An irregular area measuring approximately 60 feet in width and 200 feet in length was impacted by the release.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

On February 18, 2013 the saturated soil was scraped from the ground and stockpiles on 6 mil plastic. The saturated soil was then transported to Sundance Services on 2/22/13. On January 13, 2016, a representative from ETC and TRC met with the NMOCD representative in the Hobbs NMOCD Hobbs District Office 1 and asked NMOCD to research and investigate the potential off-site contributions to the chloride impact. On March 7, 2016, the NMOCD granted ETC permission to backfill the existing excavation with the excavated soil without condition. On March 15, 2016, backfilling was completed. Based on the NMOCD permission to backfill the excavation without condition, ETC request the NMOCD to grant ETC Site Closure Status to the 4-inch Lateral 2/18/13 Release Site.
