Thanks for the phone call. As we discussed, sample S1 is adjacent to the well head. We feel that additional sampling at this location is a safety issue, and we would prefer not to dig deeper. We will handle further work in this area when the well is P&A'd.

With respect to the shallow affected soil: We have scraped the affected soil and stockpiled them onsite. As we discussed, I would like to use the soil to bolster existing topography that has prevented spills from migrating offsite. I will collect a composite sample for chlorides. If the sample is lower than 1,000 mg/kg chlorides, we will re-use the soil onsite.

Amber, here is the spill area outlined with sample locations as I sent it to Jamie Keyes. As you can see, the release went to the edge of our pad, but not into the pasture. Sample results showed that the S1 location was elevated for chlorides, but the others were fairly low. Since the drainage of the area is to the east, we have re-used the affected soil to ensure the any potential future release does not leave the pad by building a berm on the eastern edge of the pad.
