- This location is in core habitat for LPC. Currently, BLM timing stipulations are in effect.
- There are 2 USGS wells (324600103484601; 324539103490501) south of the release location, less than 2 miles, that indicates depth to groundwater > 100 ft. bgs. Please verify and adjust permissible levels accordingly.

NMOCD approves of the proposed delineation plan for 1RP-3299. Please be advised that NMOCD database indicates release occurred on Federal surface and minerals. BLM can verify. If so, like approval from BLM required.
