BLM accepts your proposal with the following stipulations:

Once remedial activities have been completed, the area to the west of the facility where unauthorized staging of equipment has occurred, including the destroyed arch site, will need to be restored. Some form of a deterrent (temp fence, berms...??) will need to be put in place to keep vehicles off the area to allow revegetation. The area of the release that went past the facility will also need to be included in the restoration. Chevron can wait on reseeding until the appropriate time of season but in the meantime a barrier will need to erected.

NOTE: LPC Timing Stipulations are in effect - from **March 1st through June 15th**. Please plan remedial activities accordingly. Check for African Rue...treat (before it gets out of control).
