The following:

- 1. Allow at least two (2) work days of notice before plugging of initial well TW-1 and replacement of this well with new well to be used for potentially enhanced product recovery.
- 2. OCD requests that soil samples be collected at 10, 20, 30, 35 and 40 feet below ground surface for analysis of BTEX and extended range TPH (MRO, GRO and DRO) for the new well placement.
- 3. OCD approves the schedule for sampling, sampling protocol and selected laboratory Methodology for analysis of said samples.
