Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Lightning struck a 500bbl fiberglass produced water tank causing it to catch on fire and structurally compromising the tank. The wells were immediately shut in. Emergency services were contacted and the fire department was dispatched to the location and extinguished the fire. Approximately 140bbbls produced water was in the tank when the lightning strike occurred. A vacuum truck recovered approximately 100bbbls of produced water. All fluids stayed inside the earthen berm containment and on location.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The release was contained to the lined facility. The facility infrastructure was removed. Confirmation soil samples were taken. The impacted area was vertically/horizontally delineated and remediated by Talon/LPE per NMOCD guidelines.
