Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
Lightning struck a 500BBL fiberglass produced water tank causing it to catch fire and structurally compromising it. The wells were immediately shut in. The fire department assisted in extinguishing the fire. Approximately 310 BBLS of produced water was in the tank when lightning struck. A vacuum truck recovered approximately 310bbls produced water. All fluid stayed inside the earthen berm containment on location.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
The release was contained within the earthen berm on the facility. Confirmation soil samples were taken. The impacted area was vertically/horizontally delineated and remediated by Talon/LPE per NMOCD guidelines.
