This notification is to inform site assessments were conducted yesterday September 28, 2018, at the above locations in reference to 1RP-5032 and 1RP-5108. There appears to be an abundance of livestock present at both well pads where they were observed to be grazing and feeding off equipment and drinking stagnant water.

At 1RP-5108 (Severus Federal Com #003H) it was difficult to determine the location of the temporary lined frac tank where the release occurred due to the presence of several containments that appear to lack structural integrity and are open to the surrounding well pad where water can flow in and out; this is problematic in light of recent rain events in the area.

Per regulation 19.15.29.8, release site security and containment is required therefore full site assessment/characterization is necessitated for 1RP-5108 and 1RP-5032.
