Dear Mr. Baker:

Notes:

- Due to release occurring in a watercourse denoted in both USGS and OSE maps, delineation levels are considered for <50 ft bgs.
- TPH (100 mg/kg) vertical delineation is incomplete at SP-3, SP-4, SP-6.
- Maps must be scaled and clearly show release locations and sample points.

Please note that delineation for **1RP-4588** is still incomplete. In the interests of resolving 1RP-**4588** NMOCD approves the proposed remediation, however, please be advised that completion of delineation, while remediating, is considered conducted at-risk. Approval is also conditional based on the following:

1. Excavation at SP-1 up to 2 feet bgs and excavation at SP-2 up to 1 foot bgs or until RRAL's are attained.
2. Excavate SP-3 (no less than 10"), SP-4 (no less than 2') and SP-6 (no less than 10") until RRAL's are attained.
3. Both bottom and sidewall confirmation samples are required for each of the proposed depths of excavation.
4. At least one confirmation sidewall/edge sample location must be at the border between each different depth of excavation (i.e., between SP-1 and SP-2 etc.).
5. Marked confirmation sample locations in relation to delineation sample locations on a scaled map.
6. Dated photo documentation of the remediation process.
