Ms. Holland,

The NMOCD tracking number for the intermittent releases at the Blanco 3 State Com 1 site is **1RP-5499**. The NMOCD considers this an open and close release event. No further action is required under 19.15.29 NMAC for gaseous releases such as this one. However, under NMAC 19.15.29.10 A.(2), & B. the responsible party must notify the appropriate division office within 15 days of discovery of release. Therefore, NMOCD requests that Cimarex attempt to report Natural Gas release events as they occur, and not report bulk release events.

Thanks and let me know if you have any questions.

I will be attempting to enter the additional C-141 notifications sent on 5/7/2019 in short order, but it might take me some time to get through them all. Your patience in this matter is appreciated as the Division continues to experience staffing shortages.
