Oil & gas production/sales will be allocated based on wells test performed monthly.

Working interest owners are identical.

The proposed commingling of production is in the interest of conservation and will not result in reduced royalty or improper measurement of production. Estimated daily production for the Superior WA State #5 is 8 bls of oil, and 26 mcf.

The purpose of the surface/pool commingling, lease commingling, off lease storage and measurement is to reduce operating costs for storage and treating, thereby extending the economic life of each well. Without approval for utilizing existing batteries on adjacent leases, it will become necessary to build separate facilities for each well. This will greatly increase costs and shorten the economic life of the well.

The proposed commingling is necessary for economic operation of the above referenced leases.
