

Set 5 1/2" casing at 13,700', using 100 centralizers and 452 scratchers, cemented with 1675 sacks. Plug down at 2 A.M. 10-28-53. By temperature survey, top of cement outside 5 1/2" casing at 8315'. October 30, 1953, check top cement inside 5 1/2" casing at 13,665'. Did not drill out cement.
