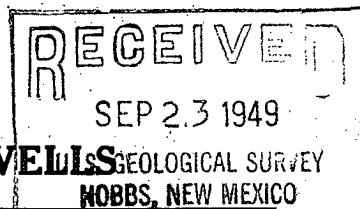

DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well with rotary tools at the above location to a depth of approximately 6,600' unless commercial oil or gas production is encountered at a lesser depth. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with.

The following casing pattern will be used:

13-3/8" casing to be set at approximately 200' and cemented with 250 sacks cement.
9-5/8" casing to be set at approximately 2100' and cemented with 650 sacks cement.
7" casing to be set at approximately 6600' and cemented with 600 sacks cement, 7" casing will be perforated opposite the main pay zone.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
