DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On May 7, 1953, acidized w/5000 gallons 15% NE acid by Cardinal Chemical Company thru Lynes Straddle packers. Acidized thru perforations in 7" casing from 6808-6832' w/1000 gallons acid. Maximum pressure 2600#. Flushed w/26 bbls. oil. Acidized thru perforations in 7" casing from 6742-6795' w/2000 gals. acid. Maximum pressure 1600#. Flushed w/56 bbls. oil. Acidized thru perforations in 7" casing from 6650-6728' w/2000 gals. acid. Maximum pressure 1600#. Flushed w/26 bbls. oil.

RESULTS: Swabbed 172 bbls. oil and 67 bbls. acid water in 24 hours. Swabbed and flowed 150 bbls. oil and 45 bbls. acid water in 24 hrs. Swabbed and flowed 121 bbls. oil and 31 bbls. BS & water in 24 hours.
