### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 9 joints 290' of 13-3/8" OD 48# H-40 R-2 SS Casing. Set and cemented at 310' w/335 sacks regular neat cement. Plug at 295'. Maximum pressure 300#. Cement circulated.

After waiting over 30 hours tested 13-3/8" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 min. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 295' to 310', tested cement below casing shoe w/400# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
