DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 3843 in lime. Shot pay formations from 3803 to 3843 with 140 quarts S.N.G. in 5" riserite shells using A&G double bomb.

Cleaned out to bottom, ran 2 1/2" tubing to bottom with packer set at 3762'. Flowed 152 barrels oil load in 3 hours through tubing. 2 million feet gas. Packer leaking. Next day flowed 106 bbl oil load in 24 hours. 1 million feet gas. Replaced packer, setting at 3754'. Treated with 7000 gallons Dowell "XX". After recovering oil load, swabbed 64 barrels oil in 13 hours. Pulled tubing.
