DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 3843 lime. Treated with 1000 gallons Dowell "XX" solution from 3683 to 3843.

Production before - On April 14, swabbed down & recovered oil load. Failed to flow.

Shut in over night to pressure up. Flowed 35 bbl oil, no water, in 15 minutes and started making nothing but gas. Gas estimated 3/4 million.

Production after - Started swabbing 1 hour after treating. Ran swab 7 times & well started flowing. After recovering oil load flowed 2 hours through tubing. Made estimated 2 million gas, no oil or water. Next day opened well 5 1/2 hours through 2 1/2" tubing. Flowed 6 bbl. oil, no water. Gas measured 5 million feet.
