FOR YOUR RECORDS: The following was submitted to NMOCD regarding this injection well.

During our recent attempt to run a MIT test the pressure dropped from 500 - 450 in 30 minutes, resulting in a failed test. Breck Operating Corp. has designed a squeeze job for this well and we have also prepared AFE's to send to all the Working Interest Owners regarding the proposed work. We have submitted the proposed procedure for NMOCD approval. As soon as we received approval from NMOCD on the squeeze job and approval on the AFE's we will proceed with the proposed squeeze job to repair this well.
