This location remediation is complete. The caliche pad, flow line and all old piping have been removed. Location is contour with the terrain and was seeded with BLM Seed Mix # 2. An earthen berm was left at the site to discourage traffic and a dry hole marker (prairie chicken protective) is in place

RE: Abandonment Reclamations and Remediation of Spills

Findings:

The objectives of reclamation are to remove all contaminants, debris, and caliche, and to restore the natural soils and contours. The location has a considerable amount of caliche and some oil contaminants. I suggest cutting a trench and pushing the caliche into it and bringing the clean sands and spread across the location leaving some minor contour, rip and seed. Do need to pick up some minor trash around the edge of the location and pasture.

There is a second site that needs to be addressed separately. It is a site just a couple of hundred feet down the access to the east and on the north side of the east/west road. This site is an old tank battery site where the tanks have been removed but the location has not been cleaned and remediated. There is a substantial amount of oil saturation that needs to be removed and/or remediated and clean soils restored that are capable of revegetating and restoring the surface similar to the surrounding landscape and seeded with the landowners preferred seed mix or BLM #2 mix.
