
Please notify the proper district office of the Division, in writing, of the date corrective actions are scheduled to be made so that arrangements can be made to reinspect the well and/or facility.

Comments on Inspection:		DO NOT RELEASE BOND. Rule 19.15.25.10 requires that location will be remediated within 1 year of plugging. Operator will need to remove transformers, fuses, conduit, and power disconnect from power pole. Also remove rod anchor on NE corner, concrete block on NW corner, polypipe and other debris on SW corner of location. Remove polyline from location to battery (line is currently connected to overflow on water tank). Please submit C103 for final inspection when work is complete. FIRST NOTICE OF VIOLATION					

In the event that a satisfactory response is not received to this letter of direction by the "Corrective Action Due By:" date shown above, further enforcement will occur. Such enforcement may include this office applying to the Division for an order summoning you to a hearing before a Division Examiner in Santa Fe to show cause why you should not be ordered to permanently plug and abandon this well. Such a hearing may result in imposition of CIVIL PENALTIES for your violation of OCD rules.

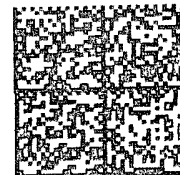
