2. Drill out CIBP @ 3326' Clean well out to original PBDT @ 3452' with reverse unit.
3. Re-perforate Yates formation 3378' – 3390', 3332' – 3368', 3312' – 3316', 3262' – 3306', 3230' – 3254', 3207' – 3224', and 3198' – 3204'
4. Acidize Yates perforations 3332' – 3390' with 3000 gallons 15% HCl.
5. Acidize Yates perforations 3198' – 3316' with 4275 gallons 15% HCl.
6. Run production equipment. Return well to production RD pulling unit.
