A member of the public informed NMOCD at 2:35 pm MST that there is a high volume of emissions coming from a new drilling location: West of the Lea County Airport, near the intersection of Lynn Rd and Hwy 62. Based on this information, the probable site is Piper 2 State #001 (API well # 30-025-43558). Please inform of situation. With the current wind conditions, uncontrolled venting poses a potential threat to the environment and local community.

Please be advised that if this is a flaring situation due to a new drilling operation, under NMAC 19.15.18.12, the Responsible Operator must submit a form C-129 before anticipated flare events.
