

The release occurred when a valve was placed in the wrong position resulting in the overflow of the oil tank. The valve was placed in the correct position.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
The release occurred within the lined facility. Vacuum trucks were immediately dispatched to recover all standing fluids. Concho will have the spill area evaluated for any possible impact from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation activities.
