The release was due to a ball-valve being partially open going into an isolated tank which resulted in the tank overflowing.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The release occurred within the lined facility. A vacuum truck was dispatched to remove all freestanding fluids. The gravel will be taken to an approved NMOCD disposal facility. Concho will have the spill area evaluated for any possible impact from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation activities.
