
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

A high pressure event in the separator occurred, sending gas and fluids (condensate) to the flare. Less than two gallons of condensate was released out of the flare, igniting a small area adjacent to the pad. The area was 10'x5'. Due to a similar reoccurrence, the facility has been shut-in until a knock out pot can be installed to capture liquids in the flare line. Marathon is also in process of installing equipment valves to automatically shut well in during high pressure events.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Contaminated soil will be cleaned up and disposed at the R360 disposal facility.
