Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

The one-inch roll line valves on the oil tanks were shut and the roll pump was powered down and out of service. The roll pump suction and discharge lines were however not isolated. The brass check valve on the #1 oil tank failed because of trapped pressure in the line. All valves on the back of the tanks were closed.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The release occurred within the lined facility. A final inspection has been conducted regarding the clean-up efforts made at the above mentioned lined facility. Free fluids were removed and if present the impacted gravel was removed from the liner and taken to a NMOCD approved disposal facility. The liner was inspected for damage and found to have liner integrity to contain free fluids.
