Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

A high pressure event in the separator occurred, sending gas and fluids (condensate) to the flare. Less than a gallon of condensate was released out of the flare, igniting two small areas adjacent to the pad. The areas were 10'x5' and 12'x7. The well was shut-in.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Contaminated soil was scraped and sent to R360 for disposal.
