The release was caused by a hole that developed in the piping on the dump line of the free water knockout. The section of pipe was replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The release remained on location within the lined facility. A vacuum truck was dispatched to remove all freestanding fluids. Concho will have the spill area sampled to delineate any possible impact from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation activities.
