This release was caused by a faulty level indicator/PLC alarm which failed to turn on the transfer pump causing the tanks to overflow. The level indicator and PLC were inspected and repaired.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

All of the fluid remained inside of the lined containment. A final inspection has been conducted regarding the clean-up efforts made at the above mentioned lined facility. Free fluids were removed and if present the impacted gravel was removed from the liner and taken to a NMOCD approved disposal facility. The liner was inspected for damage and found to have liner integrity to contain free fluids.
