Directions: Exit Hwy 176 to north just west of MM 13. Continue east on caliche road to COG's Stratojet 31 State Com No. 3H (30-025-40103).

Findings: Flare stack off the northeast corner of location. Flare stack inside diked area. Area approximately 50' x 50' clear of vegetation with flare in the middle.

Wind on Friday, May 11, 2018, reported at 17 to 24 mph out of the south with gusts up to 34 mph. Burned area traveled north to road next to the Stratocone 32 State # 1H.
