Hi Heather:

You recently contacted me about a change of operator for your company, Vanguard Permian LLC. According to you, Vanguard is trying to acquire several wells from Blue Ridge Resources LLC. Your concern was about Vanguard's inactive wells and OCD approving the change of operator.

According to OCD online, Vanguard and Blue Ridge have a change of operator application in <u>draft</u> status (draft status means that Vanguard and Blue Ridge <u>have not submitted</u> the change of operator application to OCD for approval). The

application is permit identification number 134953. The wells identified for the change of operator are the Mexico F #001 (30-025-05246); Mexico F #002 (30-025-05247); Mexico F #003 (30-025-05248); Mexico F #004 (30-025-05249); Mexico F #005 (30-025-05250); and Mexico F #010 (30-025-05255).

Rule 19.15.9.9C(1) provides that the OCD <u>may</u> deny a change of operator if the new operator is out of compliance with Part 5.9. Vanguard is currently out of compliance with 19.15.5.9 NMAC (Part 5.9) due to inactive wells. As the operator of 50 wells, Vanguard may have no more than 2 wells on the inactive well list. <u>See</u> Part 5.9A(4)(a) NMAC). Vanguard has 4 wells on the inactive well list.

Although Vanguard is out of compliance with Part 5.9 due to inactive wells, the OCD has decided to exercise its discretion and approve the above change of operator. <u>Please be advised that this approval may be withdrawn if</u> <u>Vanguard's compliance with Part 5.9 changes before the change of operator is submitted</u>.

Please be advised that Vanguard has some compliance issues that it needs to correct. Please contact the OCD's Hobbs office to correct those problems. Although this is not a complete list of the compliance issues, some of the major compliance issues include release cleanup at the HT Montieth A #1 (30-025-05336) and HT Montieth #2 (30-025-29656); obtaining NSL approval for the Skelly Q State #4 (30-025-03784) (and also correcting information on remedial work that was performed on the well); and obtaining DHC for the State SEC 1LA #22 (30-025-38962). Again, please contact the OCD Hobbs office to resolve these issues.

Vanguard also needs to provide the OCD with a correct mailing address. The OCD's Hobbs office mailed items to Vanguard's address of record but the post office returned those items due to an invalid address.
