Comments on Inspection: DO NOT RELEASE BOND. The following items were noted: 1) No operator on dry hole marker, 2) 3 concrete bases & other debris south of marker, 3) drilling line east of gas meter run, 4) barbed wire, concrete block with post sticking out and other debris SW of marker, 5) sucker rods, rod pump, and other debris on west side of location. Sites were marked with orange surveyors tape. NEED TO CORRECT DRY HOLE MARKER AND REMOVE ALL DEBRIS FROM LOCATION. Please notify this office when work has been completed to reschedule field inspection. 1st notice on non-compliance.

In the event that a satisfactory response is not received to this letter of direction by the "Corrective Action Due By:" date shown above, further enforcement will occur. Such enforcement may include this office applying to the Division for an order summoning you to a hearing before a Division Examiner in Santa Fe to show cause why you should not be ordered to permanently plug and abandon this well. Such a hearing may result in imposition of CIVIL PENALTIES for your violation of OCD rules.

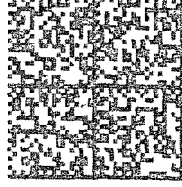
