This well was deepened to a total depth of 4034'. TD was reached on 1-19-57. The interval 3940-4034' was cored, no shows of oil or gas were encountered. R/A logs were run through open hole section 4034-3813'. Copies of these logs will be submitted when available.

This well was temporarily abandoned by running 2 3/8" OD tubing. to bottom and filling the hole with 50 sacks of mud. 5 1/2" OD casing was completely filled. No casing was removed from well but was capped at surface and 4" OD pipe marker installed.
