DETAILS OF WORK

On Aug. 25, 1955, this well was plugged and abandoned. With tubing on bottom, the hole was filled with 50 sacks of mud, completely loading the 5 1/2 casing. No casing was removed from well, but casing was capped at the surface and a 4" pipe marker inserted. No shows of oil or gas were found in well.
