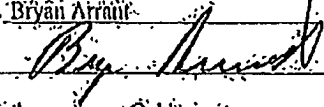

Chesapeake Operating, Inc.'s Closed Loop System

Equipment & Design:

Chesapeake Operating, Inc. is to use a closed loop system with roll-off steel pits.

- (2) Swaco DT Dual Motion shale shakers
- (1) 250 bbl/minute Derrick D1000 centrifuge
- (1) 500 bbl "frac" tank" for fresh water
- (1) 500 bbl "frac tank" brine water

Operations & Maintenance:

During each and every tour, the rig's drilling crew will inspect and monitor closely the drilling fluids contained within the steel pits and visually monitor any spill which may occur.

Within 48 hours should a spill, release or leak occur, the NMOC District I office in Hobbs (575-393-6161) will be notified. Please note that notifications may be made earlier to the district office should a greater release occur.

This is in keeping with the reporting requirements of NMOC's rule 116.

Closure:

During and after drilling operations, liquids (which apply), all drill cuttings and drilling fluids will be hauled and disposed to the Controlled Recovery, Inc.'s location.

The permit number Controlled Recovery, Inc. is: NM-01-0006

The alternative disposal facility will be Sundance Disposal.
